# Co-Worker Day Placements



At Lauriston we know the value of meaningful work and through our day placements we offer adults with a learning disability the opportunity to co-work alongside our staff in a safe, supportive and tranquil environment.



Over time, co-workers can learn new skills which contribute directly to the life of the farm and you will become part of the whole farm team comprising staff, volunteers and co-workers.



**Each 'Farm Day' runs from 10am to 4pm, costs £70 and has a mixture of activities around a core focus:**

**Monday** - processing the farm's produce & cooking everyday lunches

**Tuesday** - caring for the soil, growing vegetables, flowers & fruits

**Wednesday** - washing, felting, carding, spinning & weaving the farm's wool

**Thursday** - looking after cattle, sheep, chickens & soon pigs

**Friday** - labeling, packing, selling & delivering farm produce
